First Aid at Work (FAW)

NVQ level 2 equivalency

The Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations place a duty on all employers to ensure there is adequate first aid provision, including first aid trained personnel and approved first aid equipment, in the workplace. Personnel appointed to administer first aid and manage first aid responsibilities must have undergone approved training and hold a current First Aid at Work Certificate.

Our First Aid at Work courses are approved by the Health & Safety Executive and prepare students to deal appropriately and competently with illness and injuries in the workplace.

This course may be run either at one of our venues or in-house at your premises. We also run open house courses at our venues through out the year.

On successful completion delegates will be awarded a First Aid at Work certificate.

First Aid at Work **Refresher Course**

NVQ level 2 equivalency

For First Aiders wishing to refresh their skills and renew their First Aid at Work certificate. The course may be run either at one of our venues or in-house at your premises.

Emergency First Aid for the Appointed Person (EFAW)

NVQ level 2 equivalency

Ideal for lone or mobile workers, small organizations, those with numerous sites and low risk environments such as offices and small shops, this course provides thorough basic First Aid training.

Training may be held either at one of our venues or in-house at your premises to suit the requirements of your staff. We also run open house courses at our venues through out the year.

Emergency First Aid for Staff in Schools

NVQ level 2 equivalency

Health and Safety First Aid Regulations require schools to provide appropriate and adequate first aid equipment, and to appoint sufficient numbers of first aid trained personnel to administer first aid and to manage the first aid responsibilities within the school.

This course is designed for teachers and mid-day supervisors, and follows the first aid techniques recommended for children and adults in accordance with the Resuscitation Council (UK) Guidelines. The course may be run in-house on the school premises for groups of six or more delegates, during the day, evening or at weekends

On completion delegates are awarded an Emergency First Aid certificate.

Business owners are also liable for the health and safety of customers on their premises. The HSE has the power to issue unlimited fines for failing to comply with the regulations.

CIEH Level 1 and 2 in **Food Hygiene**

Level 1 is designed for new employees with minimal or little prior knowledge. This would include staff handling low risk or wrapped food. It would also be appropriate for those working front of house, such as waiting or check out operators; as well as back of house, i.e. kitchen porters or warehouse employees.

The HSE requires all companies to have in place a written Stress Policy. This one day course is designed to help employers and employees understand the causes of work-related stress, their effects and how to deal with them.

Fire Awareness and Fire Marshal Training

NVQ level 2 equivalency

The course is designed to help employers meet the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 which requires the 'responsible person' for the premises to carry out a fire risk assessment and nominate a sufficient number of competent persons, or fire marshals, to assist in implementing emergency procedures identified in the fire risk assessment.
